

CAP Minor Topics Babel Machine Codebook

The CAP Minor Topics Babel Machine Project uses the [Comparative Agendas Project](#) policy [codebook's minor topics](#) to identify the policy areas of texts. The codes assigned are unequivocal, mutually exclusive, and cover all potential policy topics. The codebook distinguishes 213 minor topics total across the 21 major policy areas.

You can choose between two approaches for making predictions:

Hierarchical Classification First, the model predicts a major topic. Then, a second model selects the most probable subtopic from within that major topic's category.

Flat Classification (single model) A single model directly predicts the most relevant label from all available classes (both media and minor topics).
